

Welcome to Manor 2nd floor!

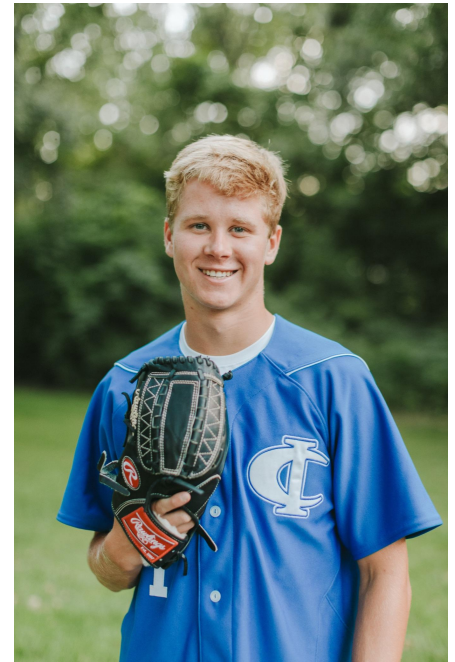
