



**Assistant Professor of Learning Technologies: Virtual Learning
Tenure-track
Advanced Degrees Department**

Hamline University's School of Education (HSE) seeks a tenure-track Assistant Professor specializing in learning technologies: virtual learning to join its Advanced Degree Department starting 2014-2015. HSE seeks candidates with expertise and experience in implementation of learning innovations to improve instruction, including technology implementation. Candidates with direct experience in multicultural settings and expertise in one or more of the following areas are preferred: curriculum and instruction, 21st century learning, research design, social justice and equity, leadership and/or organizational development, or development of learning communities. Candidates must have demonstrated ability, experience, and/or interest in working collaboratively across programs. The appointment begins August 2014.

Summary of Duties:

- Teach 24 credits per year including face-to-face and online courses primarily in the Advanced Degrees Department at the master and doctoral levels. May also teach courses in the Teacher Education department based on candidate expertise. The finalist will teach one or more courses that require expertise in building communities of teachers and learners, practicing thoughtful inquiry and reflection, and constructing knowledge and courses related to the individual's academic expertise.
- Advise graduate students and supervise capstones and dissertations.
- Participate in departmental and HSE affairs, including committees, meetings, and unit-wide work days and retreats.
- Maintain active scholarship agenda related to professional education.
- Maintain active service to the University and external communities, including K-12 schools.

Required Qualifications:

- A doctoral degree awarded by an accredited university is required at the time that the application is submitted.
- Demonstrated experience in integrating technology in the classroom and experience with online teaching.
- A minimum of 3 years work experience in multicultural educational settings.
- Knowledge of 21st-century learning outcomes and learning environments.
- Knowledge of adult learning practices and building communities of learners.
- Experience teaching in higher education settings.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience working effectively with diverse adult learners in education programs.
- Demonstrated experience advising master and/or doctoral students.
