Hamline University's School of Education (HSE) seeks a tenure-track Assistant Professor specializing in literacy to join the Advanced Degrees Department starting 2014-2015. HSE seeks candidate expertise and experience in emergent and/or elementary literacy, 21st century digital literacy, and literacy leadership. Candidates must have demonstrated ability, experience, and/or interest in working collaboratively across programs. The appointment begins August 2014.

Summary of Duties:

- Teach 24 credits per year including face-to-face and online courses primarily in the Advanced Degrees Department. May also teach literacy courses in the Teacher Education Department.
- Advise graduate students and supervise capstone and/or dissertation.
- Participate in departmental and HSE affairs, including committees, meetings, and unit-wide work days and retreats.
- Maintain active scholarship agenda related to professional education.
- Maintain active service to the campus and external communities, including K-12 schools.

Required Qualifications:

- A doctoral degree awarded by an accredited university is required at the time that the application is submitted.
- Demonstrated experience in integrating technology in the classroom and online teaching experience.
- A minimum of 3 years of successful K-12 teaching; experience working in urban or diverse settings.
- Knowledge of 21st-century learning outcomes and learning environments.
- Knowledge of adult learning practices and building communities of learners.
- Experience teaching in higher education settings.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Candidates with direct experience in formative and summative reading assessment tools, and in language development are strongly preferred.
- Demonstrated experience working effectively with diverse adult learners.
