When will I receive an I-20 so I may apply for a student visa at the U.S. Embassy?

After your application has been reviewed by the admission committee and you are admitted to Hamline University (and you have demonstrated evidence of financial support), we will send you the I-20 form with your official letter of admission; you will use these documents to apply for a student visa. You should plan early and carefully so you may schedule an appointment at the nearest U.S. Embassy. Be prepared to submit all additional documentation the U.S. Embassy official may require of you, such as a valid passport and financial information.

- TOEFL score
 - All applicants whose native language is not English must request an official score report be sent to Hamline University from the Educational Testing Service. Hamline's school code is 6265. The minimum TOEFL score of 550 (written exam) or 213 or above (computer-based exam) must be achieved. Visit www.ets.org/toefl for more information about the TOEFL exam.
- Financial Support Data
 - US visa regulations require evidence of adequate funds to meet the expenses involved in the student's proposed program of study. Please submit financial support documents from personal or other resources. Sponsors need to submit a bank statement along with a letter of support or Affidavit of Support form.
