

I, the undersigned, hereby affirm and acknowledge that Dream Big camp is providing my child with the opportunity to use the athletic facilities on campus, that my child's participation in physical activities is voluntary, and further affirm that I have been fully advised and thoroughly informed of the following information as indicated by my signature at the bottom of the page.

I understand and agree that neither Dream Big Basketball, nor any and all of the trustees, officers and directors of Dream Big Basketball, all of Dream Big employees, students, student supervisors and leaders, agents, assigns, and others involved in supervision of, administration of, or participation in any of these activities (collectively the "Released Parties") may be held liable or responsible in any way for any sickness, injury, death, or other damages that may occur as a result of my child's participation in Dream Big camp, or as a result of the negligence of any party, including the Released Parties, whether passive or active.

I hereby authorize the employees of the foregoing entities to act according to their best judgment in a situation regarding medical attention, whether an emergency or not, until such time I am contracted to make decisions concerning treatments. I understand that treatment of minor injuries such as an ankle sprain can be treated with conservative protocols such as ice packs and compression but no medication will be administered to my child without prior permission. I, on behalf of myself and my minor child, hereby release members associated with Dream Big Basketball Camp, and their agents and employees from all claims for injury or private property damage which may be sustained by my child while s/he participates in Dream Big Basketball camp. I further agree to indemnify the above listed, and to hold the foregoing entities from any and all claims for injury or property damage which are caused by, or the result of, actions or omissions of my minor child.

I hereby personally assume all risks in connection with my child's participation in the program, for any harm, sickness, injury or damage that may befall my child while s/he is a participant in the Dream Big Basketball camp, including all risks connected therewith, whether foreseen or unforeseen.

I further save and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claim or lawsuit by me, my family, estate, heirs, or assigns arising out of my child's participation in the Dream Big Basketball Camp.

I agree that if any portion of this Liability Release and Express Assumption of Risk Form is later determined to be invalid or unenforceable, that the remaining portions shall continue to be fully binding upon me.
