

# Hamline University Book Scholarship

## Scholarship Application

Established by Validis Resources, the current vendor for the Hamline University Bookstore, this scholarship is designed to assist graduate and undergraduate students in the pursuit of their educational degrees by offering book scholarships for the purchase of textbooks and academic supplies.

Students eligible for this one-time scholarship must have a demonstrated financial need and be in good academic and judicial standing. Additionally, students must submit an essay that demonstrates outstanding achievement in one of the following areas central to the mission of Hamline University: Academic Excellence, Service to Community, Commitment to Diversity or Ethical Leadership. Only students currently enrolled at the university are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

### Book Scholarship Award

Up to sixteen book scholarships in the amount of \$250.00 each will be awarded for the 2009-2010 school year. Students are only eligible to receive this scholarship once during their tenure in your current program.

### Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by the staff from the Division of Student Affairs in consultation with staff from the Student Administrative Services.
