



Earn an Elementary Science Certificate with MnSTEP! -Minnesota Science Teachers Education Project-

Hamline University's School of Education, through the Center for Global Environmental Education will offer an **Elementary Science Certificate** to those teachers completing all five MnSTEP science courses (or equivalent science content courses*) totaling 10 credits. This certificate demonstrates completion of content studies in all science disciplines around all K-5 Minnesota elementary science standards.

MnSTEP summer science courses prepare teachers to better teach concepts in physics, chemistry, biology, earth and space science, and inquiry within their science curriculum by providing increased content confidence and practice in effective science teaching strategies. The **Elementary Science Certificate** will be awarded to those teachers completing all five MnSTEP elementary science courses:

SCED 7030: Elementary Biology/Environmental Science Teacher Institute

SCED 7032: Elementary Chemistry Teacher Institute

SCED 7034: Elementary Physics Teacher Institute

SCED 7036: Elementary Inquiry and Assessment Teacher Institute

SCED 7038: Elementary Earth Science Teacher Institute
