You need to login using your Hamline username and password to use resources on campus, like computers in a computer lab or classroom, email, or to access the wireless network.


Use this ID and password to log in to online learning tools - Blackboard and Moodle. This is NOT your Piperline and Banner password.




- 2. Login using your current Hamline Username information
- 3. The first time you login, you will be required to answer 6 predefined security questions. These questions will be used to verify your identity if you forget your password in the future.



4. In the User Details screen, make sure that "Identity Self-Service" is selected, and click on "Change Password"



5. Change your password to be a minimum of 8 characters where at least one is a numeric character, one is uppercase character and one is a lowercase character.



6. Click "Submit" and your new password will active immediately.

Please note that you will be required to change your password at least every 180 days.

Note: you can also change the password for your Hamline Username when using any on-campus Windows workstation.

- 1. Login using one of the on-campus Windows workstation.
- 2. Press simultaneously the Control (Ctrl), Alt, and Delete keys.
- 3. That should bring up a window with several buttons, one button should be to "Change Password"
- 4. Click on the "Change your password" button.
- 5. Type in your old (current) password, and then type in a new password and hit enter.
