Moreover, we would prefer candidates with an interest in contributing to Hamline's East Asian Studies and Global Studies Programs, and possibly to the Model United Nations program as well. Successful candidates should be committed to effective teaching and quality scholarship. Candidates with a Ph.D. in hand are preferred. ABD candidates will be considered.
