Hamline University Endowed Chair in physics: Tenured or Tenure-track Associate Professor of Physics.

The College of Liberal Arts at Hamline University invites applications for the newly created Emma K. and Carl R. N. Malmstrom endowed chair in Physics. The appointment will be tenured or tenure-track at the associate professor level to begin fall 2014. A PhD in physics or a closely related field is required. Although all areas of research will be considered, preference will be given to an experimentalist with expertise in condensed matter physics.

The successful candidate will present a distinguished record of scholarship and of teaching at the undergraduate level, and will be expected to involve undergraduate students in research. All undergraduate faculty at Hamline advise students, participate in general education programs, and provide service to the college and university. The holder of the chair will have a reduced teaching load to better enable scholarly work and to facilitate the administration of the annual Emma K. and Carl R. N. Malmstrom endowed lecture series in physics. Significant start-up funding is available. See <http://www.hamline.edu/physics> for more details about the position, the department, and the university.

Candidates should submit (see web site for instructions) a cover letter, vita, statement of teaching philosophy, research plan identifying connections with students and, if applicable, other disciplines, and 3 letters of recommendation. Review of applications will begin on December 1, 2013, and will continue until the position is filled. Women and members of underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply.
