The Department of English at Hamline University (Saint Paul, Minnesota) invites applications for a one-year, full-time appointment as a Visiting Assistant Professor to teach in our new concentration in Professional Writing and Rhetoric. Pedagogical strength in blending rhetorical theory and practice is required; experience teaching digital media production, programming, or design is preferred. Scholars in rhetoric, composition, and/or the digital humanities are welcome to apply.

This non-tenure-track, academic-year (nine-month) appointment in the College of Liberal Arts begins fall 2014. The successful candidate will teach entry-level courses including Introduction to Professional Writing and Rhetoric, as well as upper-level courses in his/her area of expertise. The teaching load is seven courses distributed over fall, winter, and spring terms (3-1-3). PhD preferred; ABD will be considered.
