**RECIPROCITY POLICY**

The Career Services Office of Hamline University School of Law is pleased to provide the following to students and/or graduates of law schools outside of Minnesota under the following terms:

1. Services and resources are available only to students and/or graduates of other ABA-accredited law schools which allow Hamline University law students and/or graduates matching services.
2. Reciprocity services will be limited August 1 - November 15.
3. Requests for services will be accepted only in writing by an official of the requesting school's Career Services Office.
4. Requests will be honored for a period of three months from the date of approval and may be extended for an additional three months upon request. A request for an extension must be submitted by the student's or graduate's Career Services Office.
5. The following services will be provided only if, and to the extent, the student's or graduate's home school reciprocity policy offers such services to Hamline students and/or graduates (services matched):
  - \* Access to online job listings
  - \* Limited counseling services on the local market available except between August 1 and November 15.

No other services or resources are available.

6. Schools seeking reciprocity must abide by the Agreement among the Minnesota law schools stating that reciprocity is available through **one** Minnesota law school only. Students and graduates from William Mitchell College of Law, University of St. Thomas Law School, and University of Minnesota Law School are not eligible for reciprocity from Hamline University School of Law (and vice versa).
7. The Director of Career Services may deny further services to individuals who misuse the facilities or services. We also reserve the right to alter the terms of this policy without notice.
