# **Piper Logos**





Secondary logo

Primary logo

The Piper is the official mascot of the university and may be used only on athletic or sports-related apparel and materials or on other materials approved by the Office of Strategic Communications. The Piper logo should never be used to replace the official university logo without permission. The preferred logo for use is the primary mark. However, a secondary logo is provided for use on applications approved by the Office of Strategic Communications.

Only the official electronic file of the logo should be used; the logo should not be recreated in another format.

Hamline's official athletic colors are burgundy (Pantone 201), gray (Pantone 421), and (Pantone Black).

A wider color palette exists to add depth and energy to Hamline's identity. The following colors are the only colors to be used on publications, materials, and the website. Tints of these colors, as well as black and white, are also acceptable.

### Dark Color Backgrounds

Frequently it may be desirable to place the logos on a dark field of color. Shown above are the only versions of the logos allowed on dark color backgrounds. The preferred logo versions are always towards the left of the row.

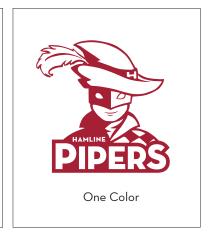

On a gray background





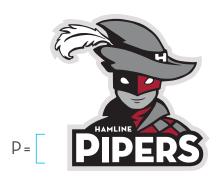




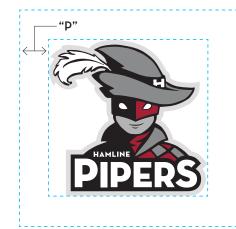
### **Light Color Backgrounds**

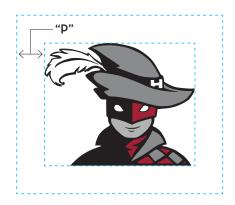
Frequently it may be desirable to place the logos on a light field of color. Shown above are the only versions of the logos allowed on light background colors. The preferred logo versions are always towards the left of the row

# Usage









### Spacing

In order to protect the integrity of the Piper logo, white space needs to be maintained around the logo's perimeter. Under no circumstances should any text or graphic intersect or be placed immediately adjacent to the Piper logo.

No matter at what size you're using the logo, leave at least a space around the logo equal to the height of "P" in "Piper" (see illustration above). The preferred amount of space is at least 1/2 inch all the way around, but the P-height is the minimum allowable space.

### **Minimum Sizing**

In order to ensure clear reproduction and legibility, the logos must not be used any smaller than the sizes shown to the right. When possible, It is preferred that the logos be used larger than their minimum size.
