What is the Common Data Set?

The Common Data Set, or CDS for short, is a collection of many various campus data points that Hamline University's Institutional Research office compiles every year. It contains ten separate sections, as follows:

- A-General College Information
- B-Enrollment and Persistence
- C-First-Time, First-Year Admissions
- D-Transfer Admissions
- E-Academic Offerings and Policies
- F-Student Life
- G-Annual Expenses
- H-Financial Aid
- I-Instructional Faculty and Class Size
- J-Degrees Conferred by Disciplinary Area

Hamline's campus is 60 acres and over one million square feet.

Hamline has 1077 off street parking spaces.*
