High School

- **51%** of first year students occasionally performed **volunteer work** in the past year; **34%** frequently did
- Students chose to **attend college** because of **better job prospects**, to learn more about things that interested them, and to be able to make more money
- **58%** of students previously had **occasional experience** looking up scientific **resources and articles**.

First Years

- **Half** of first year students reported they **never participate** in activities to enhance their **spirituality** (**34%** sometimes participate)
- Quality of **academic advising** was rated as excellent/good (**84%**)
- **73%** of students felt they **understood people** of other racial/ethnic backgrounds **very much/quite a bit**
- The majority of first year students do not work off campus; **43%** **work on campus 1-15 hours a week**

Seniors

- **48.4%** of students spent an average of **11 or more hours studying/preparing for class**
- **Satisfaction with academic advising** is also at the highest percentage in the last several years at **92.3%**
- Students report being **generally/very satisfied with Hamline** (**95%**)
- More students held **unpaid internships** (**51.1%**) than **paid internships** (**22.4%**) in 2013

Alumni

- **68.4%** of surveyed alumni are **employed full-time** (including **full-time paid internships**)
- Of those that are employed full time, **87%** are **Very satisfied/satisfied** with their job
- **79%** of those employed full time had **1-2 internships at Hamline**, compared to **42%** of those **employed part-time** who had **1-2 internships**
