Health Services staff can provide:

- Physical exams / wellness visits
- Treatment for a wide range of illnesses and injuries
- Contraception and reproductive services including pap tests, and STI testing and treatment
- Minor procedures including wart treatment, mole excision
- Psychiatric medication consults and prescriptions
- Lab services
- Immunizations (Tdap and flu)
- Limited pharmacy on-site

- ★ All services are confidential, and there is no charge to meet with a provider
- ★ Lab fees can be billed to health insurance plans; prescription costs can be charged to student accounts
