The Sustainability SLS position coordinates between the Student Activities Department and the Sustainability program, whose student corps is called the Thrive Team. By assisting and working independently on tasks surrounding Sustainability education and the Wasteless Campaign on campus, this SLS candidate will help encourage sustainable behavior change and education.

How to apply

- Applications will be available online on February 1, 2021.
- Review this document and check for eligibility.

- Scroll to the bottom of the page and select “Apply Now”.
- Complete the application. If selected for an interview, you will be contacted by email for scheduling.
- Visit the Career Development Center if you would like assistance perfecting your resume.

Essential duties will include:

- Campus waste reduction and education efforts, including outreach and social media use.
- Community engagement with students, staff and faculty.
- Developing sustainability programs, potentially including connections to Hamline courses, and to the Hamline Free Store, and Hamline gardens and MicroFarm.
- Working with Residential Life, Student Activities, and other campus programs and organizations to collaborate on sustainability-related activities and initiatives.
- Assisting the Sustainability Office with its ongoing internal/external operations, including communications (social media, email updates, newsletter, etc.) and documentation (potentially but not necessarily including creative media such as photography, sketching, audio/video, and performing arts).

Sustainability Project

Both SLS sustainability student workers will work together (and with other members of the Thrive Team) to determine a semester-long project involving sustainable change on campus. Work must involve project feasibility, timeline management with defined tasks for each month and measurements for success once implemented.
